



RACE RULES - CHALLENGE FREJUS

Article 1 - French Triathlon Federation

Challenges FREJUS sur mer is registered in the official calendar of the French Triathlon Federation. Consequently, it is subject to the FFTRI 2023 sports regulations available on the Federation's website. The competitor who registers for this event automatically accepts the FFTRI 2023 sports regulations and the specific race rules of these regulations.

Article 2 - General conditions

Swimming :

A cap will be offered by the organization to each competitor and its wearing is compulsory. Goggles and wetsuit are allowed according to federal rules applied to the L & M distance: the wetsuit will be compulsory if the water temperature is less than or equal to 16°C and forbidden if the water temperature is greater than or equal to 24.5°C. The swimming part will be cancelled if the water temperature is less than or equal to 12°C. It is forbidden to wear the number during the swim. Athletes will be identified by a numbered tattoo to be placed on the left shoulder.

Bicycle :

Wearing a helmet, approved hard shell, with the chinstrap fastened and adjusted, is compulsory from the start to the return to the bike park during the whole cycling event. Movement on foot in the bike park. As the circuit is not closed to traffic, it is requested to scrupulously respect the traffic regulations. Competitors are not allowed to draft behind another competitor (7m for the M & 12m for the L), or a vehicle (35m) during the race (drafting prohibited).

The competitor is not allowed to overtake an athlete by more than 25 seconds.

Bib not folded, placed on the back, accompaniment by a third party forbidden, headphones forbidden. The bike park is only accessible to competitors, the organisation, the press, photographers and referees.



Removal of the bike after the arrival of the last cyclist of the corresponding size (M or L), only on presentation of the chip to the organisation.

Running :

Wearing a helmet is forbidden, headphones are forbidden, race number not folded on the front part of the body, accompaniment by a third party is forbidden.

Relay

For the Relay event, teams may be female, male or mixed. A team is composed of a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 3 persons.

Article 3 - Race Briefing & Referee Briefing

Race Briefing

The race briefing will take place the day before in the Challenge Village at the podium. All race information will be given and the organiser will answer any questions you may have. An athlete's guide will be sent to you at D-7 before the race.

Referee briefing

Competitors are required to attend the competition briefing. It will take place 10 minutes before the start of the competition, in the swimming start area.

Article 4 - Prize-giving ceremony

The presence of the winning competitors is compulsory. Otherwise, no prize can be claimed later by the absent competitor. The organiser reserves the right to dispose of the prizes as he sees fit.

Article 5 - Civil liability of the organiser

The Challenge organisation holds a "competition licence" issued by the FFTRI and is insured under the FFTRI MAIF contract N° 4464742. It therefore benefits from civil liability cover, against the financial consequences of its civil liability, whatever the nature that may fall to it in the context of its activities. The following are insured: the organiser, its managers, its staff and its volunteers, in the context of the organisation of the event. The damage and guarantees are defined in the insurance contract available on the FFTRI website. The organiser is also covered for criminal defence and recourse following an accident. The organiser takes out two additional optional guarantees offered by the FFTRI: damage to following vehicles and following boats (damage and civil liability guarantees).

Article 6 - Guarantees granted to competitors

Competitors must be aware of the risks inherent in this type of sporting event, which requires prior training and excellent physical condition. Non-licensed FFTRI and FFTRI leisuers and managers holding a Competition Pass are covered by the civil liability policy N°4464742 of the FFTRI. The damages, guarantees and amounts are listed in the contract which can be consulted on the FFTRI website. Holders of the Competition Pass only benefit from "civil liability" cover. FFTRI licence holders with a "competition" licence also benefit from individual accident cover and "assistance" cover (organisation and payment by Mondial Assistance of the return home. The Competition Pass will nevertheless be free of charge for the Triathlon federations of the following countries Germany, England, Belgium, Spain, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Portugal and Switzerland. You must also provide us with a copy of your ITU licence for validation. The equipment is not covered by any federal insurance. No guarantee of

The French Triathlon Federation does not offer any personal insurance guarantee. It is up to the athlete who is licensed with a foreign triathlon federation affiliated to the ITU (if the licence of his own federation does not already cover him) to take out a personal insurance policy in his own interest, with the insurer of his choice, to cover the bodily injuries to which his sport may expose him.

Article 7 - Cancellation of the event in case of force majeure

In the event of cancellation or permanent interruption of the event for any reason beyond the control of the organisation, and, in particular, any case of force majeure, any decision of the public authorities (in particular for reasons of public health, safety or preservation of public order), any risk of bad weather or proven bad weather, the organiser will not incur any liability whatsoever with regard to the competitors and the registration fees will not be refunded. Competitors hereby waive any claim or request for reimbursement whatsoever as a result of such cancellation or interruption. If you subscribe to the Cancellation Option, 100% of the registration fee (excluding active.com fees) may be refunded. (See Article 14)

Article 8 - Image rights and CNIL

Competitors expressly authorise the competition organiser and their beneficiaries such as partners, sponsors and the media to use the animated (audiovisual) or still (photographic) images in which the competitors may appear, taken during their participation in the competition, on all existing or future media, including promotional and/or advertising and/or institutional media, throughout the world and for the longest period of time provided for by the law, regulations and treaties in force, including any extensions to this period. The participant acknowledges and accepts that the organiser is entitled to record these still and moving images (photos and videos) and agrees to their use.

CNIL: The registration form may be used for any purpose by the organiser, unless the participant expressly stipulates otherwise. The participant has the right to access and rectify any personal data concerning him/her, in accordance with the "Informatique et Liberté" law of 6 January 1978.

Article 9 - Referee

The present rules are subject to French law. Any dispute arising from or in connection with these rules shall be submitted to the FFTRI for arbitration in accordance with its rules or, failing that, to the Sports Arbitration Chamber attached to the French Olympic and Sports Committee, and shall be finally settled in accordance with its rules.

Article 10 - Registration fees

The registration fee covers only participation in the competition, to the exclusion of any transport, accommodation or meal expenses or any medical expenses, which remain the responsibility of the competitor.

Article 11 - Conditions of access to the events

Registration in the M format: from Junior to Master: 18 years and over

Registration in L format: from Junior to Master: 18 years and over

FFTRI licence holders: Licence to be presented at the time of number collection + proof of identity.

Non FFTRI licence holders: Fill in the Competition Pass on site and pay it when collecting the numbers the day before the race (20€ for the M, 40€ for the L and 2€ for the relays). The payment of the Competition Pass for non-licence holders is to be paid in cash or by cheque to the order of the FFTRI.

A medical certificate of no contraindication to the practice of triathlon in competition, less than one year old at the date of registration, must be presented at the time of registration.

Holders of a FFTRI leisure licence or a FFTRI executive licence without the mention competition must provide a medical certificate of no contraindication to the practice of triathlon in competition and pay the price of the Competition Pass.

For the relays:

The F.F.Swimming licence exempts the medical certificate for the competitor doing the swimming part, but not the payment of the Competition Pass. The F.F.Cycling licence exempts the competitor from the medical certificate for the cycling part, but not from the payment of the Competition Pass. The F.F.Athletics licence exempts the competitor from the medical certificate, for the running part, but not from the payment of the Competition Pass.

Foreigners :

Licensees of the following Federations: Germany, England, Belgium, Spain, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Portugal, and Switzerland must present their licences

of the 2022 season to be downloaded on the registration form. They are exempt from the Competition Pass. However, athletes will have to sign the Competition Pass when collecting their numbers.

Triathlon licensees from other federations (USA Triathlon) will have to present their licenses of the current season and have to download it on the registration form. They will also have to take the Competition Pass option when registering and sign the Competition Pass when picking up their numbers.

Incomplete file: For all incomplete registration files on the day of the event, the competitor will not be able to take the start and the number will not be given. No reimbursement will be made in this case.

Article 12 - Medical structure

A rescue agreement has been established with the Protection Civile with medical teams composed of doctors, nurses and first aiders will be present: Security HQ, DPS, Vehicles on the bike and running course.

Article 13 - Safety during the event

Swimming: BNSSA, Kayaks, Paddle, Jet-Ski, Boat, DPS, Race Doctor (Approximately 20 people)

Bicycle: Municipal police, 90 signallers, opening cars and brooms, 20 motorcyclists, DPS

Running: Mountain bike openers, team of 30 people, DPS, Doctor, Police

Article 14 - Cancellation - Cancellation Option - Transfer - Change of number

Cancellation option

By subscribing to the Cancellation Option (20€ for the L, 10€ for the M, 30€ for the M or L Relay) at the time of your registration, you benefit from the opportunity to cancel your registration up to 15 days before the event (see last paragraph) and be reimbursed 100% (excluding Activ.com fees), without any justification (at the current rate, even in the case of cancellation due to force majeure - Article 7).

If you do not subscribe to this guarantee, there will be no 100% reimbursement of your race number, even in case of force majeure.

For non-members, the full amount of the Competition Pass will be taken into account.

Transfer of races

Transfers between the different challenges are not possible.

Change of race number with a third party

Changes of race number holders are possible up to 15 days before the event.

The holder of the number must send us the changes by email on info@challenge-frejus.com

Name, first name, licence or medical certificate.

If the new holder is not a licence holder, he/she will have to pay the Competition Pass. Exchanges of race numbers on the day of the event will not be accepted.

Please note that for insurance reasons, your number cannot be exchanged and is personal to you.

In case you change your number unofficially and contrary to the rules of the Challenge, the person participating in your place will not be covered by any insurance in case of accident.
